Presentación

Estudio de la fonética y fonología de la lengua inglesa. Análisis contrastivo con respecto a la lengua española. Teoría y práctica.

Programa Básico

Esta asignatura tiene como objetivo la adquisición del vocabulario técnico preciso que permita a los alumnos describir con exactitud el modo de articulación y la producción de los fonemas de la lengua inglesa, descubrir las leyes que llevan de la ortografía a la pronunciación y alcanzar un nivel óptimo en la pronunciación y capacidad de discriminación de sonidos en lengua inglesa.

Objetivos

This course is divided into three main sections: Theory, Transcription and Pronunciation. Every week, one hour will be devoted to each section.

The goal of the first section, Theory, is to develop a deep knowledge of all the sounds used in the English Language, and to master a precise descriptive language. The goal of the second section, Transcription, is to discover and learn many rules and areas of regularity which allow us to connect spelling and pronunciation, and to develop skills of text-transcription. The goal of the third section, Pronunciation, is to learn to pronounce all the sounds of the English System.

Programa de Teoría

Section 1: Theory

Introduction: Organs of Speech and Voice Production

1. Description of English Vowels and Diphthongs
2. Description of English Consonants.
3. Nature and Levels of Stress.

Section II: Pronunciation

Every week, an hour will be devoted to pronunciation practice. Sessions will take place in room 304 (aula multimedia). Here the student brings into practice the knowledge acquired in the Theory section under the supervision of the teacher. This section is organized in two parts:

Part 1: Vowels

Part 2: Consonants

Section III: Transcription

Every week, an hour will be devoted to the practice of transcription: simple and complex words in isolation, as well as texts.

Programa Práctico

During the first semester laboratory practice will focus on the acquisition of vowels.

During the second semester laboratory practice will focus on the acquisition of consonants.

Evaluación

By handing in, within deadline, tasks and papers, students may obtain part of their final grade. Also by succeeding in the many quizzes that will be presented to them during the course part of the grade may be earned. Finally, there will be a final exam, consisting of a written part (for Theory and Transcription) and an oral exercise (for pronunciation). The minimum required for passing this final exam largely depends on the student's progress as shown by papers, tasks and quizzes.
